Gifts of Healing

1 Cor.12:9, 28-31

Facts:

I. "Gifts" is Plural.

A. Some have greater success in some areas than others-- different gifts. Ex. deaf, blind, asthma, skin diseases, emotional bondage

II. Healing Different than Miracles

A. Healing is relieving the body of disease. It may be gradual

B. A miracle produces changes that go beyond healing. (lengthen a leg, replace an organ, etc..) note: casting out demons is working miracles - Mt.12:22.

III. All Believers Can Lay Hands on the Sick

A. Mk.16:18, cp.. 1 Jn.2:20, 2 Cor.1:21

IV. Gifts of Healings are Special Anointings of the Spirit

A Lk.4:18-19, Jn.3:34, Acts 10:38

V. We Must Differentiate Between Healing by Faith and Healing by Gifts

A. Mk.5:27,34 cp.. Rom.10:17

B. Gifts as the Spirit wills - Jn.5:2-13

VI. Gifts of Healings are Ministered in Different Ways

A. Laying on of hands - Mk.16:18, Mk.5:23,41, Lk.4:40 Acts 28:8,9

B. Anoint with oil - Jms.5:14, Mk.6:13 c.

C. The spoken word - Mt.8:5-10

D. Anointed cloth - Acts 19:11,12
